You were previously advised we wero consulting with othor Government agoncy(ies) [OGA] concerning information located as a result of your Freodom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA) roquest.

By letter dated May y, Z005 we referred the enclosed puge to the Defense Incelligence Agency (DIA) for the application of any excmptions they decmed appropriate. Although we requasted that they respond directly to you, the DJA returned the pages to the FBI by letter dated May 10, 2007. Rather than return it to the DIA and further delay the process, we are providine you with the disclosure. The excmpted information is FB information withheld by the PBI, not DIA information withheld by the DIA.

(U) <br> (U) On Friday, July 12, 1996, at approximately <br> New York while attempting to capture the sunriseb 7 C on videotape, recorded what appeared to him at the time to be the plume from a rocket. An analysis of the tape revealed what appears to be a grey trail of smoke asceriding from the horizon at an angle of approximately $75^{\circ}$. During the colirse of the tape, jis even overheard stating to his friend that "they must be testing a rocket." shortly after viewing the tape at home, he calculated that this missile was traveling toward the Atlantic Ocean. On July 23, 1996 $\square$ was interviewed at the same location from which he shot the video image. After establishing several points of reference, an azimuth was established of $70^{\circ}-72^{\circ}$ north magnetic. Subsequent calculations placed this.plume in the vicinity of the Long Island Sound on a line of sight over the towns of Rocky Point and Miller place. |

approximately 2530 of 7.17.96, while on maritime excursion out of Captree (Fire Island). The boat was traveling east relatively close to the shore. From the deck she observed 0 aral boat traveling east very close to the excursion boar. Wines described the bot ar being "very odd", "round in Front, shaped like an old-fashioned bath tub", "it was duly. black in color and half the size of a good sized motor boat." Tho boat's cabin was draped with a very thick, beige plastic cover. The witncoo added that protruding through the center of the boat. through the roof and plastic was a cylindrical tube which appeared to be as big as the boat itself. The cube appeared to have the diameter of a tennis ball. She observed one male at the rear of the boat, and felt that there must have been another individual piloting the craft. The witness described the individual on the boat as having dark hair and a moustache.
